User Manual

Junction box Model: DAHUA DH-PFA132-E

The Dahua DH-PFA132-E Junction Box is an accessory designed specifically for Dahua fisheye security cameras, providing a safe, tidy and weatherproof installation. This model allows you to organize the cables properly and protect them from environmental factors that may affect their operation.

1. Features

- **Compatibility:**Compatible with Dahua EBW8 series fisheye cameras.
- **Durable material:**Constructed of high strength aluminum alloy.
- Protection against external conditions: IP66 rated to protect against dust and moisture.
- **Easy access design:**Provides quick access to cables and allows for a clean installation.
- Vandalism resistance: Withstands harsh outdoor conditions and protects the camera connection from damage.

3. Technical specifications

4. Installation

Prerequisites

- Make sure you have a suitable and stable surface for installation.
- Make sure the area is free of dust and moisture before starting.
- Prepare the necessary tools: screwdriver, drill, level.

Installation instructions

- 1. Select the location: Choose a suitable and safe location for installing the junction box, close to the fisheye camera.
- 2. Mark mounting holes: Use the base of the box as a template to mark the hole locations on the mounting surface.
- 3. Drilling holes: Drill the marked holes and insert anchors if the surface requires it.

- 4. Mounting the junction box:
 - Secure the box to the surface with the screws provided.
 - Make sure the box is level and tight.

5. Cable connection:

- Open the lid of the box.
- Pass the camera cables through the cable entry hole.
- Connect the cables according to the camera instructions.

6. Sealing:

- Place the rubber gasket on the inlet hole to ensure tightness.
- Close the junction box cover and make sure it is tight to prevent dust or water from entering.

7. Camera mounting:

- Install the fisheye camera into the junction box according to the camera manual.
- Make sure it is firmly attached and properly aligned.

Note:It is recommended to perform a connection test before fully securing the box, to ensure that the camera is working.

5. Maintenance and care

- **Cleaning:**Periodically clean the outside of the case with a dry cloth. Do not use solvents or abrasive detergents.
- YO**Inspection:**Check the integrity of the rubber seal and the tightness of the case every three months to ensure that no water or dust enters.

6. Safety precautions

- Install the junction box in a suitable location and away from direct reach of water, unless fully secured in an IP66 environment.
- Avoid installing in humid conditions or with the junction box connected to a power source.
- Always turn off the power before handling cables to avoid electric shock.

7. Troubleshooting common problems
